(Terrorism and its impact on the condition of women. During the 2014 war against ISIS (ISIS))

Women and Terrorism is a scientific study in the contextualization (socio-political of gender) of the issue of terrorism, its relations and its effects on women. In this study, we focus on the issue of women and terrorism after the war against Daesh in Iraq and Syria in 2014. Our research focuses on Kurdish women in Western and Southern Kurdistan and women supporting terrorist groups. This research is based on previous studies, interviews with women victims and women defenders participating (fighters) in these terrorist groups.

In this research, we try to explain the phenomenon, causes and structure of terrorism from a gender perspective, to understand the differences in the social aspects of gender according to different societies, as well as to identify the different types of terrorism in the relationship with women. The status of women is parallel to the historical relationship between women and violence.

In this study, we will work on three questions and each question takes its own dimension in this study, including:

The first question, which saw itself in the dimension of the character of women as victims of terrorism and how?

Our field of research here will be women who have been victimized in two ways

The first method: Women abducted by ISIS, including Yazidis and women who have been sexually assaulted, for example

Method 2: Women who have been displaced with their families due to war, our research field (Qushtapa camp) in Erbil, Kurdistan, Iraq.

Question 2: Women as fighters against terrorism and how do you confront terrorism? Here are two ways:

Method 1: (Armed) Our sample of women who are fighting against ISIS with the Women's Protection Units (YPJ) in northeastern Syria, known as West Kurdistan.

Second method: In the form of civil society, our research example is the Iraqi Kurdistan Region, also known as (South Kurdistan). The women who work in civil society organizations will be our research field.

Question 3: The dimension of women and participation in terrorist groups. Why do women join terrorist groups and how?

The first method: - In the form of (armed) Our research example was the battalion (Khansa) was an organized armed battalion on the armed movements (ISIS) in (Raqqa).

Method 2: With the support of our research community, Hul camp in southwestern Syria.

The importance of this study lies in the attempt to distinguish the roles that women hold in society, to show all the difficult factors and conditions that affect the image of women, and to seek the reasons that make women major protagonists in the issue of terrorism (whether she is a victim or fighter against these groups or a follower of terrorism). This research can thus fill a small scientific gap on the issue, constituting a resource, for researchers and experts, in the future for research in this political field.

This research is in line with the research carried out in recent years, in the world in general, and in the West, in particular on the issue of terrorism. We try to conduct a different, specific and in-depth reading of the problem of terrorism and its relationship to women. We also try to answer a number of questions raised about these gender changes that have blurred the image of women in the context of the issue of terrorism. Between the traditional image of women that has always been transmitted to us regarding the distribution of women's roles in society, that women are destined for family life and the duty to raise children, we arrive in this study at classifying this duty socially and politically.

One of the reasons that pushed me to work on this issue is personal: first of all as a person who lives in a region of political instability and an atmosphere of extremism, which affects us directly, in Iraq in general and in the Kurdistan region in particular. I myself was the victim of a terrorist attack on May 13, 2007 in Makhmour, Mosul governorate. This incident marked me forever, psychologically. The other personal motivation is the need for me, as a woman, to understand the nature of women in this region and the roles they play in society.

This research consists of two parts: the first one is about the theoretical aspect of contextualization (socio-politics of gender), which includes several chapters. In the first chapter, we will focus on defining concepts such as terrorism, women's issues and ISIS. In the second chapter we will talk about women, them in terrorist groups and the reasons that motivate them to adopt such an extremist ideology. As for the third chapter, we will propose solutions through the prevention, protection and awareness of women to join terrorist groups, the fight against this phenomenon through civil society organizations and the role of the media in raising public awareness. The second part of our research concerns the field investigation. The focus of our research is Iraq in general and the Kurdistan Region in particular with western Syria. We have chosen these two areas as the area of our research because most of the clashes and incidents in the fight against Daesh have taken place in these areas. The first chapter concerns women as victims of terrorist groups such as ISIS. In this chap.
